



Woodbine Racetrack is home to the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame.





The Queen's Plate was founded in 1860 by Queen Victoria. It is Canada's oldest thoroughbred horse race. The Queen's Plate is the first race in the Canadian Triple Crown, it is followed by the Prince of Wales Stakes and the Breeders' Stakes. The Queen's Plate has been running at Woodbine Racetrack since 1956. The great Canadian horse Northern Dancer won the Plate back in 1964. You can see a statue of Northern Dancer at the entrance of Woodbine Racetrack.

DESIGN YOUR OWN JOCKEY SILKS!


DID U KNOW




THE SQUARE GAME
